Dear Pierce Park Family,

There are about 650 different prayers in the Bible but it is very difficult to get an exact number of how many times that the word "prayer" is mentioned in the Bible as every version is worded slightly differently. But, I think we would all agree it is important. There are approximately 450 recorded answers to prayer in the Bible. Again this is an important subject. There are many different types of prayers: the prayer of faith, the prayer of agreement (also known as corporate prayer), the prayer of request (or supplication) when we take our requests to God, the prayer of consecration, the prayer of intercession, the prayer of thanksgiving and the prayer of worship. The prayer of worship is similar to the prayer of thanksgiving. The difference is that worship focuses on who God is. Sometimes, prayer is a time of setting ourselves apart to follow God's will.

In Luke 11, the Lord Jesus was asked to teach us to pray, and we see what is known as the Lord's Prayer. Luke 11:1-4 says, "Now Jesus was praying in a certain place, and when He finished, one of His disciples said to Him, 'Lord, teach us to pray, as John taught his disciples.'" And He said to them, "When you pray, say: 'Father, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Give us each day our daily bread, and forgive us our sins, for we ourselves forgive everyone who is indebted to us. And lead us not into temptation.'" (ESV). Prayer is conversation with God and should be made without ceasing (1 Thessalonians 5:16-18). As we grow in our love for Jesus Christ, we will naturally desire to talk to Him. So no matter when or how, I encourage you to pray to our Lord.
